2. Purpose: To outline the Commandant's Safety Program.

3. Protecting our resources, both personnel and property, equates to value added assets that enhance our ability to accomplish our mission successfully. Composite risk management serves as the Army's primary tool in accident reduction by providing a systematic process for identifying, assessing and controlling hazards. Safety, achieved through the integration of composite risk management, is commander's business. The following procedures are in effect:

a. Commandants, commanders, directors, managers and supervisors are safety officers for their activities.

b. Composite risk management shall be an integral part of planning, preparation and execution of all operations and training developed or conducted.

c. Command risk decision authority will be in accordance with reference 1a. The standard for risk management is leadership, at the appropriate level of authority, making informed decisions to control hazards and minimize risk.


5. I expect all leaders to prevent accidents and injuries through personal involvement, composite risk management integration and adherence to standards.
