
2. Purpose: To outline the Commandant's Privately Owned Firearms (POF) policy.

3. Staff, faculty, and students will store POFs as outlined in Fort Bliss Regulation 27-5 and summarized below.

- Registration of Privately Owned Firearms: Service members and civilians who reside permanently or temporarily on Fort Bliss in family quarters, bachelor officer quarters, bachelor enlisted quarters, or troop barracks, will register all privately owned firearms with the Provost Marshal Office within 72 hours after arrival at Fort Bliss or within 72 hours after acquisition of the firearms. Pending registration, individuals will store all privately owned firearms in a unit arms room. Soldiers residing in barracks or BEQ/BOQ must store POFs in unit arms room even after registration is complete.

4. Fort Bliss Reg 27-5 POF registration requirements apply to all assigned/attached USASMA personnel. It is a leadership responsibility to ensure all Soldiers are in compliance with this sensitive requirement.
